



1. INTRODUCTION:

The J&K Board of Technical Education (JKBOTE) came into being as an individual entity under the Directorate of Technical Education in 1981. It has been transformed into an autonomous body by an Act of 2002, by the then State Legislature. The dimensions of work perfected by JKBOTE have incremented manifold over the years with a boost in the number of courses offered by the Polytechnics with a simultaneous escalation in the number of institutions in the UT.

JKBOTE has been entrusted with the responsibility for admission to Three Year Diploma in Polytechnic Professional Courses (Engineering & Non-Engineering) and the responsibility to ensure transparency and objectivity in making the admissions to these courses.

For the academic year 2023, the JKBOTE shall recommend candidates for admission to the first semester of various full time Three Year Diploma Polytechnic Courses on the basis of academic merit of qualifying examination of the candidates

TERMS AND EXPRESSIONS:

Certain terms and expressions used in the information brochure have specific importance unless, of course, the context otherwise denotes. For the benefit of the candidates, these terms and expressions are briefly defined hereinafter:-

- ❖ **Advertisement Notification:** means the notification issued by the JKBOTE for inviting online applications from eligible candidates for admission in three year diploma in polytechnics;
- ❖ **Application Form:** means the online Application Form available on the official website (<https://www.jksbotelive.com>) of the JKBOTE to be submitted by the eligible candidates for admission to Three Year Diploma in Polytechnic Courses;
- ❖ **Available Seats:** means the seats against which admissions for Three Year Diploma in Polytechnic Courses are made as per AICTE approved intake capacity;
- ❖ **Eligible Candidate:** means a candidate who fulfills the requirements of eligibility as prescribed by AICTE and the UT Government;
- ❖ **Incomplete Form:** means the Application Form which is wrongly filled in or contains false information of any kind or not having required and /or valid certificates or has any other deficiency and discrepancy whatsoever;
- ❖ **Late Receipt:** means the date after the date fixed for submission of Online Application Form meant for three year Diploma Engineering Course and notified in the admission notification;
- ❖ **Merit List:** means the list of candidates, who apply for admissions drawn up in the descending order of merit of qualifying exam;
- ❖ **Private Technical Educational Institutes:** means the Institutions/Colleges established and/or administered by registered societies, public trusts or religious and charitable trusts offering professional courses and duly recognized by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir and other regulating bodies;

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Candidates applying for admission to Diploma in Polytechnic Courses must fulfill the following eligibility conditions namely:

A candidate must:

- be domicile of either UT of J&K or UT of Ladakh, as the case may be;
- have passed Secondary School Examination (Matriculation or equivalent examination) from a recognized statutory Board for all the courses offered except Medical Lab. Technology for which the candidate must have passed 12th in medical stream. The candidates appearing/appeared in qualifying examination can also apply for the admission;
- have obtained at least 35% marks in 10th /12th class in case of both open merit and reserved category candidates;

Note: *There is no upper age bar for admission in polytechnics.*

3. RESERVATION AND CATEGORY CODES:

- ❖ The following reservation Policy shall be implemented as per S.O-127 dated 20-04-2020 of seats in the Government Diploma Polytechnic Engineering/Non-Engineering Courses:

**As per S.O. 69 dated 28-02-2020 and OM No. SW/PSP/04/2017 dated 09-05-2020 issued by Social Welfare Department of J&K Govt. the benefit of Reservation under EWS clause shall be available only in respect of those institutions, where the intake capacity of seats has been increased by the competent Authority from time to time for the said purpose.*

***TFW is a supernumerary reservation quota, reserved for those open merit candidates whose annual income of the family from all sources is less than Rs. 6.00 lac or likely to change as & when notified by UT of J&K.*

- ❖ Further, as per Rule 14 of SRO 294 of J&K Reservation Rule dated 21.10.2005, the following reservation is also made in favor of following:

a) Children of defense Personnel (CDP) :-	03%
b) Children of Para Military Forces and UT Police Personnel :-	01%
c) Candidates possessing outstanding proficiency in sports:-	02

- ❖ A candidate seeking admission under a reserved category as specified under SRO 294 of 2005 read with S.O. 127 of 2020 dated 20-04-2020, as amended from time to time by UT Govt. of J&K, is required to upload self-attested copy of the relevant certificate issued by the designated authority along with the online Application Form (Annexure-I).
- ❖ A candidate claiming benefit under sports category must also upload the certificates along with online application Form and must submit copies of these certificates in the office of the Secretary, J&K Sports Council for sports points well before the last date fixed by the J&K BOTE. For the purpose of determining the merit of sports category candidate, 60% and 40% weightage shall be given to the merit obtained in the qualifying exam and sports points respectively.
- ❖ Reserved category certificate in the name of the applicant duly issued by the Competent Authority (Annexure-I) shall have to be uploaded with the Online Application Form;

Note: *The above reservation policy is subject to change as & when notified from UT Govt. of J&K from time to time.*

- ❖ The provisions of reservation under SRO-294 are not applicable for admissions in Private Colleges but Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) is applicable to all the Colleges, Private as well as Government. Benefit of reservation in Government Colleges, including Tuition Fee Waiver shall be available only if the category to which a candidate belongs is mentioned in the On-line Application Form. Request at any stage for change or inclusion of category shall not be entertained;
- ❖ All the sanctioned seats in the Government and Private Colleges shall be filled on the recommendations of the JKBOTE. However, a specific percentage of seats approved by the J&K Government shall be filled by the management of Private institutions in accordance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, under the supervision of the Chairman, Constitutional and Monitoring Committee constituted by the J&K Government or as per the applicable rules otherwise notified by the competent authority. All the admissions in the Management quota of Private Colleges shall also be made only from the candidates who have applied for admission.
- ❖ Only female candidates shall be admitted in Government Women Polytechnic Lower Shiv Nagar, Jammu and Government Women Polytechnic, Bemina, Srinagar. In Government Polytechnic Jammu, 15 numbers of seats are reserved for female candidates in Travel and Tourism Branch. In Kashmir Government Polytechnic, Srinagar, 15 seats are reserved for female candidates in Computer Engineering branch.
- ❖ Reservation for candidates for admission in various Professional Courses:
 - The reservation of admissions shall be applicable only in Government-run Colleges as notified by the Government from time to time, unless otherwise prescribed specifically or notified for any private College;
 - The percentage of seats to be allotted to each category shall be such as notified by the Government from time to time;
 - The benefit of reservation shall be available to the concerned candidate only if the self-attested photo copy of the valid category certificate is uploaded with On-line Application Form with relevant Code Number;
 - Where a category certificate has not been issued by the designated authority, the candidate shall not be given an opportunity to validate it after the expiry of the last date for submission of the Application Form;
 - No notice shall be given to a candidate whose category certificate has been found invalid by the JKBOTE and such a candidate shall be considered in open merit, if found otherwise eligible;
 - The category certificate issued after the expiry of the last date for submission of online Application Form shall in no case be

- accepted;
- No under process certificate shall be accepted/ entertained at any cost. It also includes under process certificate for the renewal of category certificate;
 - The category certificate must be valid at the time of submission of online Application Form as well as at the time of counseling. Where a candidate has valid category certificate at the time of submission of the form but its validity period is to expire before the date of counseling/admission, such candidate shall get his certificate renewed by or before the date of counseling/admission, otherwise he/she will not get benefit of the category;
 - Where a candidate fails to submit reserved category certificate along with the “Application Form”, his/her application will be considered under Open Merit category, if found otherwise eligible;
 - A candidate can apply/opt for one reserved category only and choice regarding reserved category once exercised shall be final and at no stage shall be allowed to be changed.
 - A candidate will be considered only for one reserved category for selection against the seats reserved for that category for which code has been recorded at relevant Serial No. of the Application Form even if he/she is eligible to be considered for seats available in more than one category;
 - JKBOTE shall follow a rotational policy of odd / fractional seats of contiguous categories by clubbing them together to make it a whole number seat which shall be allotted to the candidate of the clubbed categories by following rotational policy between male and female candidates where such reservation is provided under rules and shall be allotted to higher rank candidate,
 - JKBOTE shall try as far as possible to incorporate the seat matrix in the Brochure for each course in the year in which admission is made.”
- ❖ Competent authority:
- Authorities competent for issuing reserved category certificates shall be such as notified by the Government from time to time: Provided that in the case of Children of Defense Personnel other than core service, a candidate having a certificate that his/her father is working in Defense Establishment (Military Engineering Service or other service of like nature) where salary is paid out from Defense Estimates is not entitled to the benefit of CDP Category;
 - Where this certificate is wrongly accepted and the candidate gets admission on the basis of this certificate, the admission of such candidate will be cancelled as and when this mistake comes to the knowledge of JKBOTE or brought to its notice;
 - Provided further that the candidates having “Outstanding Proficiency in Sports” must submit their certificates to the Secretary, J& K Sports Council for awarding points which will be then officially forwarded to the JKBOTE by the Sports Council. The JKBOTE shall not be responsible, where a candidate fails to submit certificates to the Council or Council fails to forward the points of a candidate to the JKBOTE. It shall be the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that his/her sports points is forwarded by the Council to the JKBOTE.” The sports category candidates must upload one set of the sports certificates along with the Online Application Form within the last date prescribed for submission of the Form in the admission notification to be issued separately”;
 - The Children of serving BSF, CRPF, ITBP and CISF do not fall under CDP category but fall under the category of JKPM for which Category Code is different. The candidates claiming benefit of any of these categories must ensure under which category they fall and should accordingly enter the Category Code;
 - The category candidates should ensure that their reserved category certificate is issued by the designated competent authority and is uploaded with the Online Application Form strictly in accordance with the Guidelines given in the E-Brochure. All the category certificates issued/dated after October, 2005 must be issued under SRO 294 of 2005. The certificates issued under earlier SRO will be accepted only if they are dated prior to October, 2005. The candidates should insist on the certificate issuing authority to make

- mention of SRO 294 in their certificates if they are issued after October, 2005;
- Where a category certificate has not been issued by the designated competent authority, the candidate will not be given an opportunity to validate it after the expiry of the last date for submission of the online Application Form. No notice will be given to a candidate whose category certificate has been found invalid by the JKBOTE and such a candidate will be considered in open merit, if found otherwise eligible;
 - The certificate issued after the last date for submission of Application Form is over will not be accepted;
 - If a candidate feels aggrieved by the decisions of the JKBOTE regarding distribution or clubbing together of fractional seats of reserved categories, he/ she is free to make representation to the Secretary of JKBOTE on any working day within one month from the date of issuance of Advertisement Notice. Thereafter, no such representation will be entertained;
 - No person in the JKBOTE is authorized to guide any applicant. The information furnished by the applicant in the online Application Form shall be deemed to have been given by him/ her;

- It has been observed that students often get confused with 'SC' and 'OSC' reserved categories and choose incorrect category in their Application Forms. It is hereby made clear that 'SC' stands for Scheduled Caste category and 'OSC' stands for Other Social Castes, which has a different category Code than 'SC' given in Brochure,

Note: - Fee fixation is not the responsibility of JKBOTE. The information given is only for the convenience of candidates.

5. ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

- ❖ The Application Form has to be submitted online only through JKBOTE websites: (<https://www.jksbotelive.com>; <https://admission.jksbotelive.com>) or through URL's/ links provided for this purpose –within the prescribed date to be notified separately. The application fee payment is to be made online through “Integrated Payment Gateway” with the help of any national Credit Card/Debit Card/UPI facility. The procedure for filing Application Form and eligibility etc of the candidates has been given in detail in the Information Video, the link of which is available on Admission Portal. The students must necessarily, in their own interest, go through this Brochure/Video before attempting to fill up the online Application Form. The candidates can download admission notification, Brochure, instructions and all other relevant information from the official website of the JKBOTE.
- ❖ The applicants are advised to fill the online Application Forms on their own or through a responsible person. The applicants can also contact the “Help Desk” of JKBOTE on 0191- 2430650 / 9906231420 (Jammu), 0194-4039265 / 7006163952 (Srinagar), email: helpmesbote@gmail.com for any assistance/guidance in this regard on any working day within the last date prescribed for submitting Online Application Form.

❖ **Submission of Online Application Forms:**

- The candidates (Both Open merit and Reserved Category) have to submit Online Application Forms only within the last date prescribed in the admission notification,
- The candidates can change/modify their online Application Form at any time before they submit it. Once the form is submitted, the entries made therein cannot be changed. It is in the interest of the candidate to make double check before submitting the online Application Form. They are advised, in their own interest, not to share their login details with anybody, lest he/she may get an opportunity to change important details in the Application Form. They can check the status of their Application Form on the official website of the JKBOTE. If any form is not confirmed for want of required information, the candidate concerned must report in the JKBOTE office by or before the stipulated date fixed for this purpose in the admission notification, failing which his/her Application Form shall be rejected.
- The online Application Form has to be submitted on internet at the address: <https://admission.jksbotelive.com>

❖ **Certificates to be produced / attached:**

- ❖ The candidates have to upload the following documents with their online Application Form.
 - Certificate of candidate belonging to UT of J&K or UT of Ladakh (Domicile Certificate), as the case may be;
 - Marks certificate of the qualifying examination issued by the concerned Board (10th class marks card for Diploma Polytechnic (12th Class marks card (Medical) for candidates who opt for Medical Lab Technology course);
 - Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate indicating Date of Birth,
 - The category candidates claiming benefit of any reserved category including Sports and TFW have to upload self-attested copy of their category certificate within the prescribed last date.

❖ **Instruction for Photographs:**

Candidates must follow the following instructions while uploading the photograph:

- Please ensure that the photograph is taken in a light colored background;
- The photograph image to be uploaded must be in JPG/JPEG format ONLY;
- The minimum size of the photograph should be 50 KB
- Photographs must be snapped on or after 01-01-2023;

- Photograph should be without a cap and sunglasses. However, spectacles are allowed.

❖ INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCEDURE FOR FILLING UP ONLINE APPLICATION FORM:

- The steps of filling up the online application form (on <https://admission.jksbotelive.com>) are given hereunder:

1. **Create an Account:** For New Applicant, create your account by clicking on the “Sign up (New Applicant)”. You need a working mobile phone with a valid SIM card having incoming facility to receive an SMS.
2. Once the account is created, login to the admission-portal using the credentials set in step 1 above.
3. For All Branches except MLT, the eligibility is 10th pass. Choose the correct area for the same and hit “Apply” Button.
4. For MLT Branch, the eligibility is 12th pass with medical subjects. Choose the right area for the same and proceed by clicking on “Apply” button.
5. **Enter Personal Details:** Name, Father’s Name, Mother’s Name, Date of Birth, Gender, e-Mail, and Adhaar number. The fields marked * are mandatory. Once all the mandatory fields are filled, hit the “Save and Proceed” button.
6. **Enter Academic Details:** Choose Grading System whether Marks or CGPA System and fill up all the related fields (Marks Obtained, Max. Marks, or CGPA Obtained, Max. CGPA and Board from which 10th is cleared) given on the page.

NOTE: *In case of Result Awaited Candidates, the student needs to upload the Board Roll Number slip of 10th Class for regular diploma course or 12th Board Roll Number slip for MLT diploma course*

7. **Enter Address:** Choose the UT as Jammu & Kashmir or Ladakh, District and Full Address. Hit “Save and Proceed” to move to next page.
8. **Upload Documents:** Choose your photograph (passport size in formal dress code with light background) and hit “Upload” button. Choose 10th Marks Card and hit “Upload” button. Choose “Domicile” and hit the “Upload” button. Hit “Save and Proceed” to move to next page to fill preferences. Documents uploaded need to be in JPEG format only with size 50kb or more.
9. **Fill Preferences:** You need to fill at least four preferences to move to next page.
10. **Preview:** The “Preview” page will let you preview all the details entered so far. You go through the details shown on this page and ensure that the details entered and the documents uploaded are correct. In case, there needs to be any information which requires modification, hit “Edit Details” and/or “Edit Preferences” button(s) to make the necessary changes before final submission of form and before making the payment.
11. **Payment:** Next step is to make the payment. “Pay Fee” button will take you to Internet Payment Gateway page where you can use one of the multiple payment modes provided for making payment. The Debit Card users should make sure that e-Commerce facility is enabled on their debit cards. In order to enable the e-Commerce facility on the debit card, you can use the respective Back Account Android/iOS App like MPayDelight in case of J&K Bank Account holder to enable the e-Commerce facility on your Debit Card before using the same for the online payment of fees.
12. **Print Form & Fee Receipt:** You can use “Print” button to print the form or save it for your reference and/or you can hit the “Print Fee Receipt” button in order to print or save the fee receipt for reference.

NOTE:

- *Fields marked with asterisk are mandatory.*

- *File size of photographs and images to be uploaded need to be 50kb or more.*
- *All documents uploaded need to be in JPEG format.*

6. DETERMINATION OF MERIT

- Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in qualifying examination (10th class/ 12th Class for MLT courses) by the candidates;
- For the purposes of allotment of seats to the reserved category candidates in Government Polytechnic Colleges, inter-se-merit within each reserved category shall be taken into consideration;

7. DECLARATION OF RESULT:

The merit list of all the eligible candidates will be published in two local dailies and will be uploaded on the website of the Board www.jksbotelive.com. The process of counseling for allotment of seat/institution will be notified separately.


